

REALTORS® WIN - Hamilton County Approves 30% Property Tax Rebate: A Victory for Homeowners

Hamilton County homeowners received welcome news this week as the County Commissioners voted to approve Commission President Alicia Reece's motion to adopt a 30% property tax rebate for this year. This decision provides critical relief to families and homeowners amid skyrocketing property valuations and significant increases in tax bills.

The REALTOR® Alliance of Greater Cincinnati (RAGC) played an active role in advocating for this outcome. RAGC leaders submitted public comments in support of the initiative, and over 300 REALTORS® sent emails to the Commissioners, urging them to adopt the rebate.

RAGC Board of Directors member Jason Kunkel reflected on the decision, saying, "We understand this is a one-year deal, but if there ever was a year that families and homeowners need some financial reprieve, this is it."

Incoming Advocacy Committee Vice Chair Maura Black also spoke in support of the motion, emphasizing, "If we can successfully meet the annual promise to the stadiums, then we can definitely meet the promise to homeowners for one year."
